

Tee Time Golf Favor

Janome Supplies:

- MC500E machine
- SQ20b or SQ14b Hoop

Fabric & Notions:

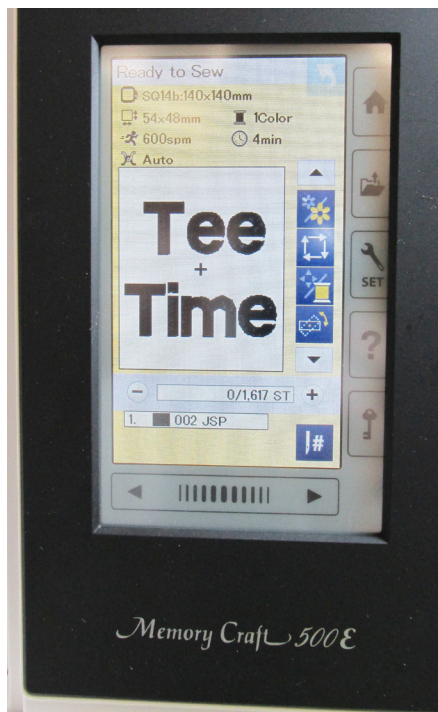
- 1/4 yard of sheer fabric or tulle
- 6" cording for loop
- Scraps of wash away stabilizer
- Decorative thread



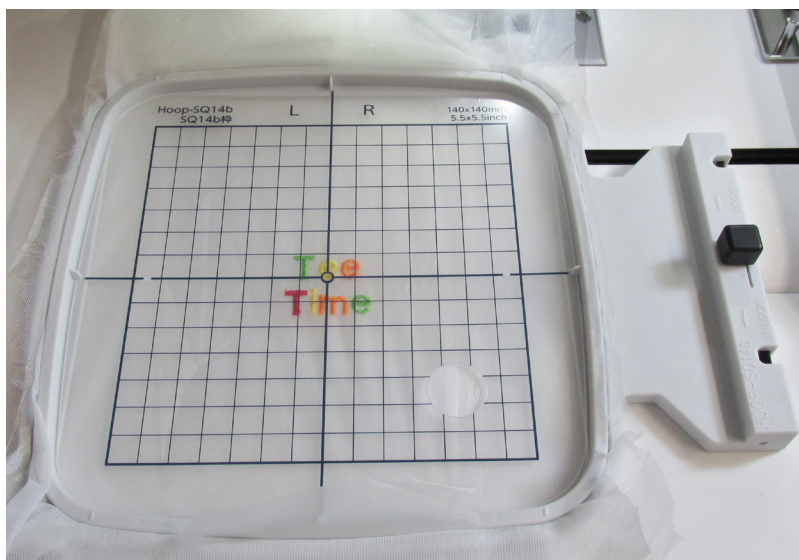
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Getting Started:

- Select a Gothic font in the smaller size on the Memory Craft 500E embroidery machine.



- Hoop the sheer fabric or tulle with a layer of wash away stabilizer on the bottom and one layer on the top.



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- Embroider the Tee Time, changing the color of the thread for each letter if desired. Remove the majority of wash away stabilizer from the front and back. Sprinkle it with water to remove any residue.



- Cut two 4" squares of sheer fabric, centering the embroidery in the center. Luveta used pinking shears for this.

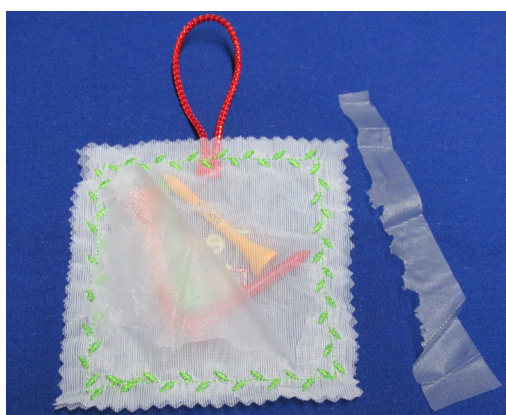


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- Place golf tees between the two sheer squares with wash away stabilizer on the underside to stabilize the stitch pattern. Pin securely, inserting the 6" of cord for hanging the loop.



- Select decorative stitch and stitch all four sides to the wrong sides together (1/2" from the raw edges). Luveta chose a leaf design.
- Remove the wash away stabilizer from the underside.



- This would make a great favor for a golf friend or door prize at your local golf tournament. Let's sew for a hole in one!
