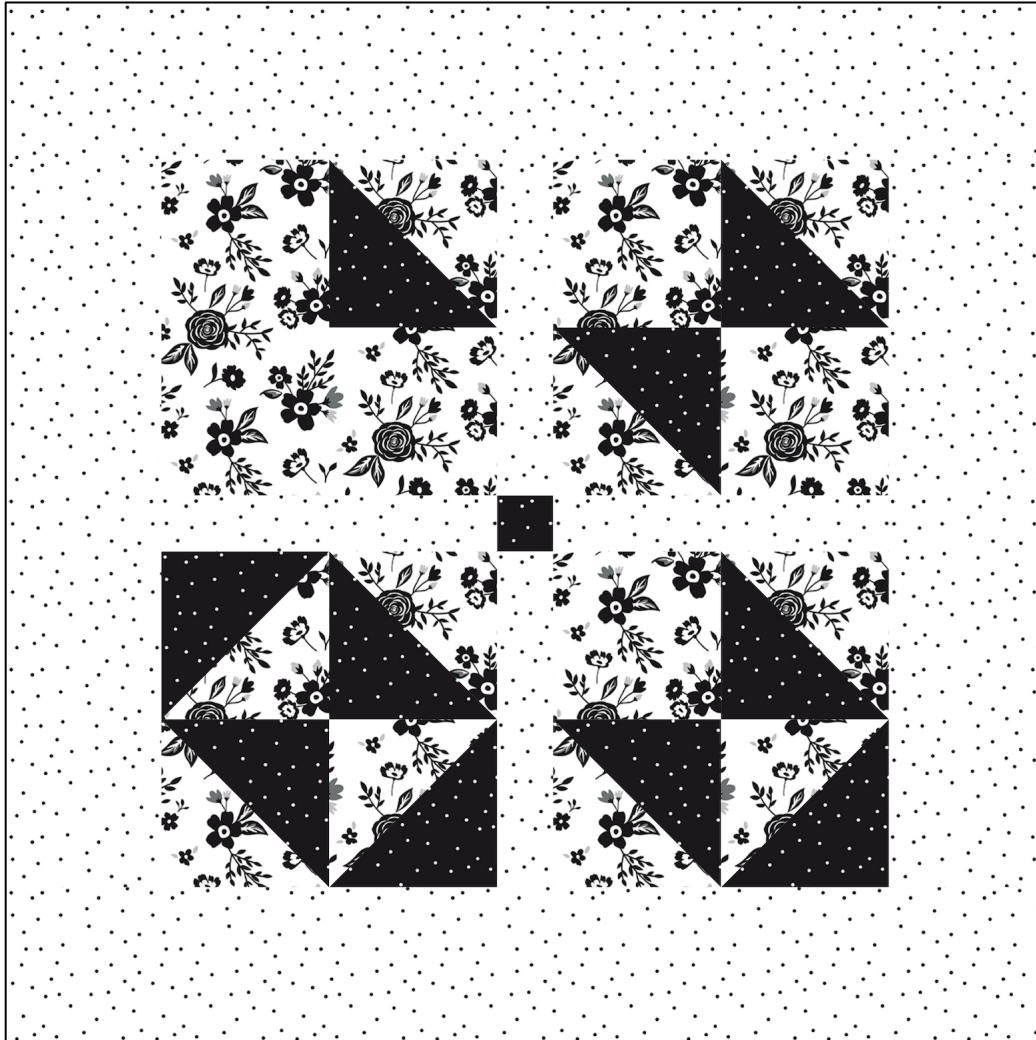


# -- Add One Pillow--

Please read all instructions prior to beginning. Seam allowances are ¼”.

## --- Fabric Requirements ---

1 Fat Quarter: Black Floral on white (blocks)

1 Fat Quarter: Black (blocks)

½ yard: White (sashing and border)

22” x 22” Batting

24” x 24” Pillow front backing \*Optional. This fabric will be hidden in pillow interior.

Backing fabric: Size will depend on preferred method for Pillow Backing Closure

20” Nylon Zipper

18” x 18” Pillow Form

\*Fabric used in cover pillow – Black Tie by Riley Blake Designs

## --- Cutting Instructions ---

Black Floral on white (blocks)

- Cut (5) 3.5” x 3.5” squares. Label A
- Cut (5) 4” x 4” squares. Label B

Black (blocks)

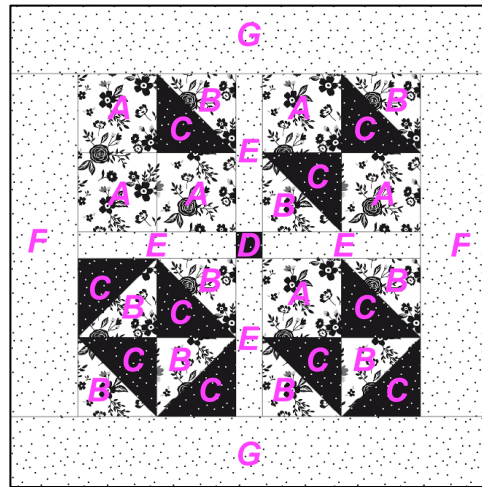
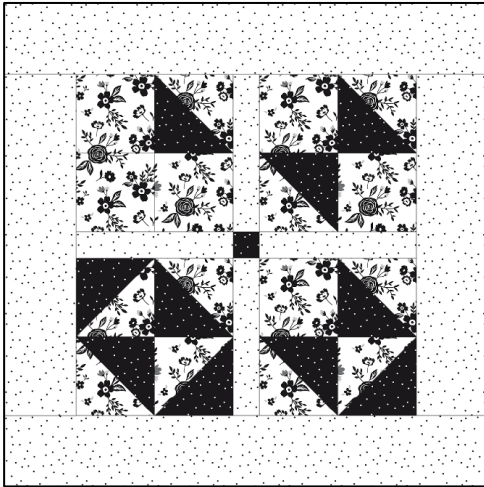
- Cut (5) 4” x 4” squares. Label C
- Cut (1) 1.5” x 1.5” square. Label D

White (sashing and border)

- Cut (4) 1.5” x 6.5” rectangles. Label E
- Cut (2) 3” x 13.5” rectangles. Label F
- Cut (2) 3” x 18.5” rectangles. Label G

# Add One Block Assembly

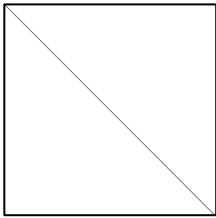

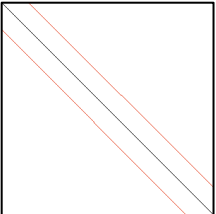
## --- Piecing Instructions ---

### A. Piecing Half-Square Triangles

- Draw diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of (5) B 4" x 4" squares.



- Place (1) B 4" x 4" square on top of (1) C 4" x 4" square. RST. Sew 1/4" away from each side of drawn line. You will sew a total of two lines – lines should be 1/2" apart. Sewn lines are in red.



- Cut between the two sewn lines. Press toward fabric C. You will have (10) B/C half-square triangles.



- Trim (10) B/C half-square triangles to 3.5" x 3.5" squares.  
Tip: Use a 3.5" Bloc-loc half square ruler for easier trimming.  
OR AccuQuilt 3.5" x 3.5" unfinished half-square triangle die for a no-trim method.

## B. Create Corner Units

### Corner Unit 1

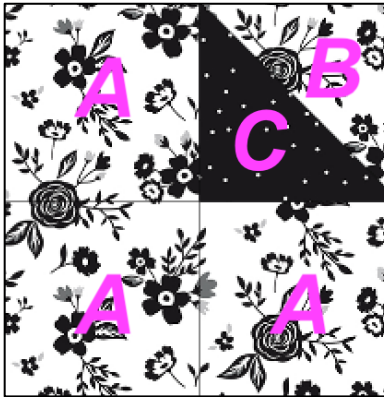
- Sew together (1) A 3.5" square and (1) B/C 3.5" half-square triangle. Press towards A. Label Unit 1a.



- Sew together (2) A 3.5" squares. Label Unit 1b.



- Sew together Unit 1a and Unit 1b. Press seam open.

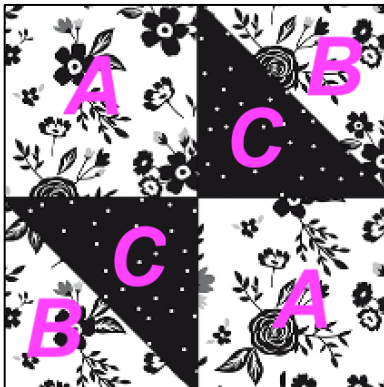


### Corner Unit 2

- Sew together (1) A 3.5" square and (1) B/C 3.5" half-square triangle. Press towards A. Make 2.



- Sew together as shown in image below. Press seam open.



### Corner Unit 3

- Sew together (1) A 3.5" square and (1) B/C 3.5" half-square triangle. Press towards A. Label Unit 1a.



- Sew together (2) B/C 3.5" half-square triangles. Press seam open. Label Unit 1c.



### Corner Unit 4

- Sew together (2) B/C 3.5" half-square triangles. Press seam open. Make 2.



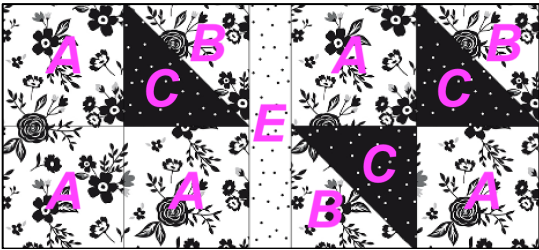
- Sew together as shown in image below. Press seam open.



## C. Pillow Front Assembly

### Row 1

Sew together Corner Unit 1 + (1) E 1.5" x 6.5" rectangle + Corner Unit 2. Press towards E.



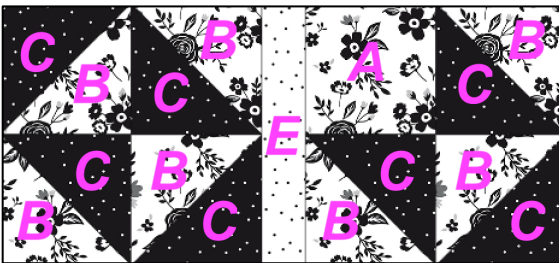
### Row 2

Sew together (1) E 1.5" x 6.5" rectangle + (1) D 1.5" x 1.5" square + (1) E 1.5" x 6.5" rectangle. Press towards E

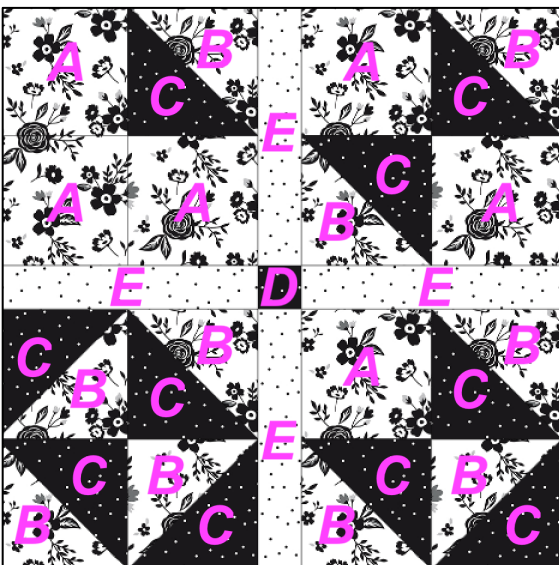


### Row 3

Sew together Corner Unit 4 + (1) E 1.5" x 6.5" rectangle + Corner Unit 3. Press towards E.



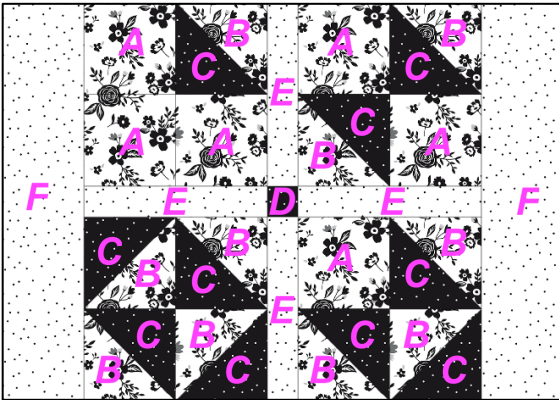
Sew Row 1 + Row 2 + Row 3. Press towards Row 2



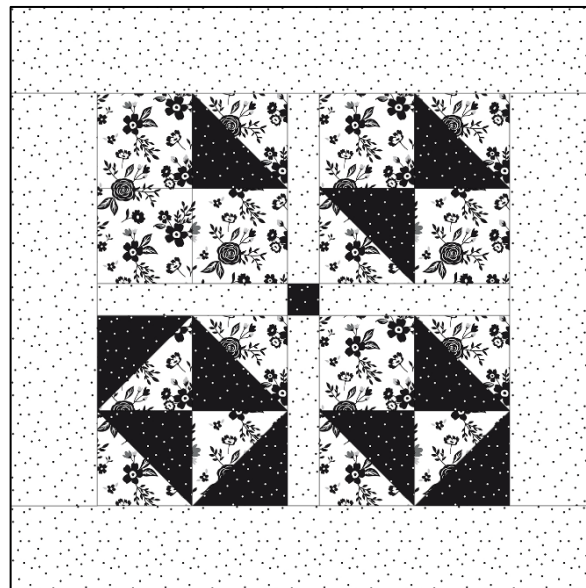
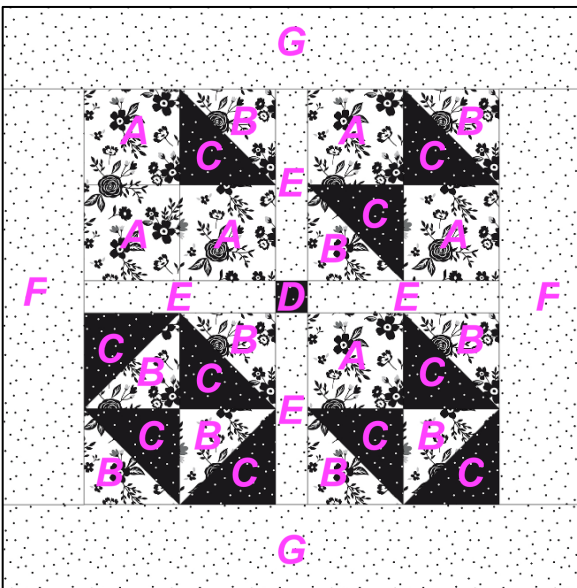


## Attach Borders

Sew (1) F 3" x 13.5" border rectangle to right and left side of Add One block center.



Sew (1) G 3" x 18.5" border rectangle to top and bottom of Add One block center.



Quilt and finish pillow with preferred method \*.
