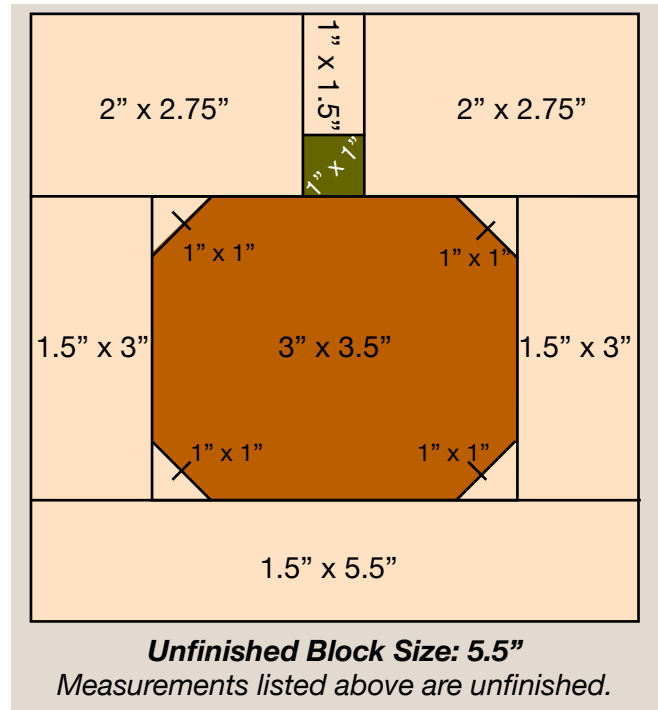
a mini quilt block pattern by Brittany Lloyd

- Skill Level: Confident Beginner
- All seam allowances are 1/4"
- Diagrams are not to scale
- All measurements listed are unfinished

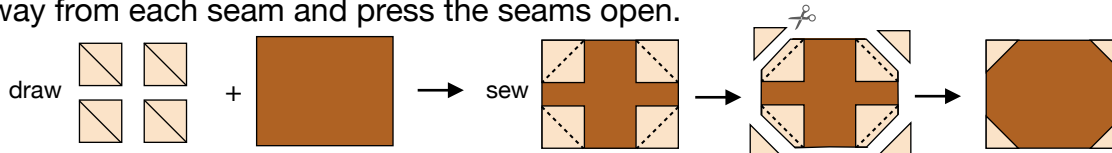
CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Pumpkin- 3" x 3.5"
- Stem - 1" x 1"
- Background -
 - 1" x 1.5"
 - 1.5" x 5.5"
 - (2) 1.5" x 3"
 - (2) 2" x 2.75"
 - (4) 1" x 1"

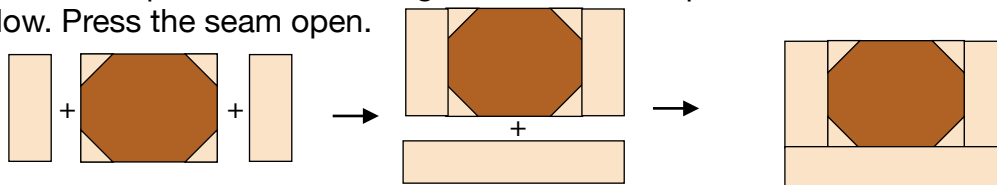


Sewing Instructions

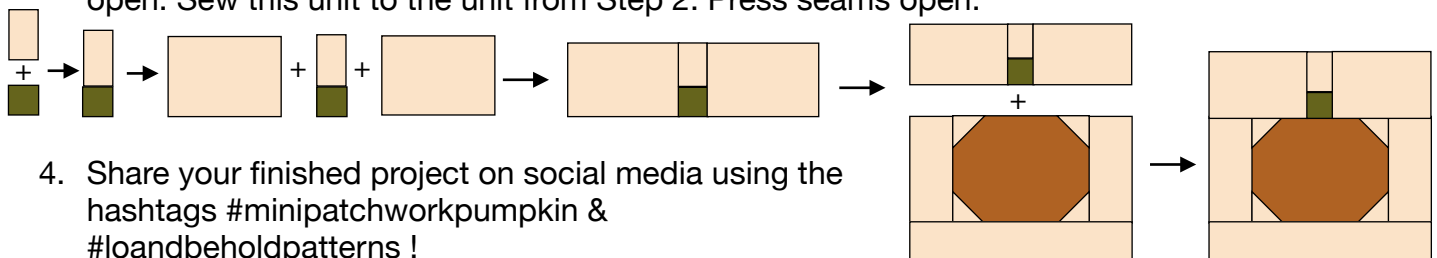
1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of all four Background 1" squares. Place the squares right sides together on all four corners of the Pumpkin 3" x 3.5" piece as seen below. Align all edges and sew on each of the drawn lines. Trim excess fabric 1/4" away from each seam and press the seams open.



2. Sew a Background 1.5" x 3" piece to both shorter sides of the unit from the previous step. Press the seams open. Sew the Background 1.5" x 5.5" piece to the bottom of this unit, as seen below. Press the seam open.



3. Sew the Background 1" x 1.5" piece to the Stem 1" square. Press the seam open. Sew a Background 2" x 2.75" piece to both sides of this unit, as seen below. Press the seams open. Sew this unit to the unit from Step 2. Press seams open.
