

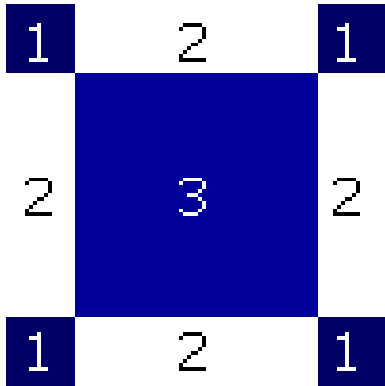
## The Quilted Pear

size: 17 1/2" x 17 1/2"



### MATERIALS

Main surface	size/amount
Pear body and Binding	1/2 yard
Pear core	3" x 4"
Seeds, corners and backing	(1) fat quarter
1 (4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	
2 (4) 3 1/2" x 11"	
3 (1) 11 x 11	
Heat n Bond Feather Lite	1/4 yard
Cotton Batting	18" x 18"



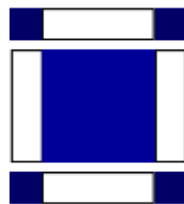
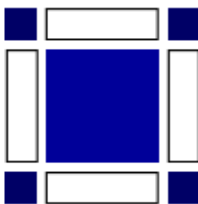
**TOOLS**

- Elna Sewing Machine
- Walking foot
- Thread
- Pencil
- Rotary Cutting tools
- Iron

**DIRECTIONS**

**Step 1**

Using ¼ inch foot assemble block as illustrated. Pressing seams well between each step.



**Step 2**



Trace applique pattern onto paper side of heat n bond. Press heat n bond to wrong side of fabric. Cut along drawn applique lines. Peel away paper backing and place fabric side up on center of quilt block. Press in place.

### Step 3

Spray baste block to batting. Stitch around applique shapes once or twice.

### Step 4



Spray baste backing fabric to back of batting. Quilt along seam lines by stitching in the ditch and  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch from the edge. Square up.

### Step 5

Prepare binding. Cut (2) 2 – inch strips of fabric. Join on 45 degree angle. Fold in half and press with right sides out. Apply binding around edges.
