Block A / Month 1

You will need:

- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

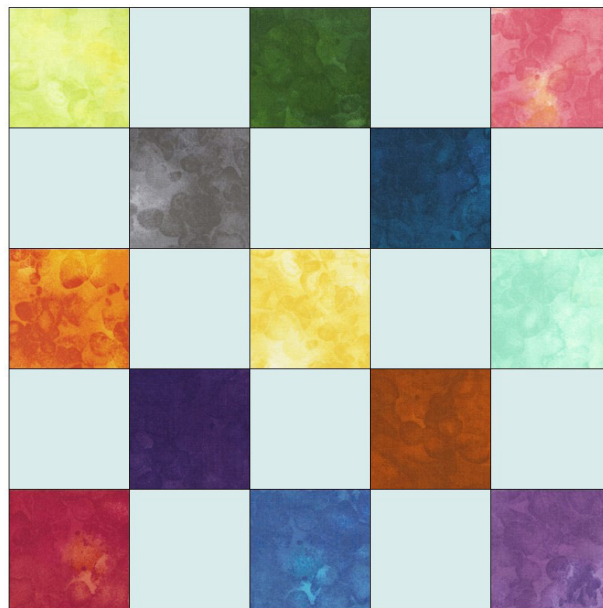
Cut:

Background fabric:

- 12 - 2½" squares from one background fabric strip.

Cut the following from each of Citrus, Green, Fuchsia, Stone, Azure, Orange, Lemon, Mint, Violet, Rust, Magenta, Sapphire, and Grape:

- 1 - 2½" square.



Block size: 10½" unfinished

Block assembly:

- Arrange the cut squares as shown in the diagram.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the squares into rows.
- Press the seams towards the background squares, then sew the rows together.
- Press the seams open.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to 10½" x 10½" if necessary.
