

Janome BOM

Block B / Month 2

You will need:

- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

Cut:

Background fabric:

- 2 - 3½" squares
- 2 - 2½" squares
- 2 - 1½" x 3½" rectangles
- 2 - 1½" x 4½" rectangles

Cut the following from each of Lavender and Magenta:

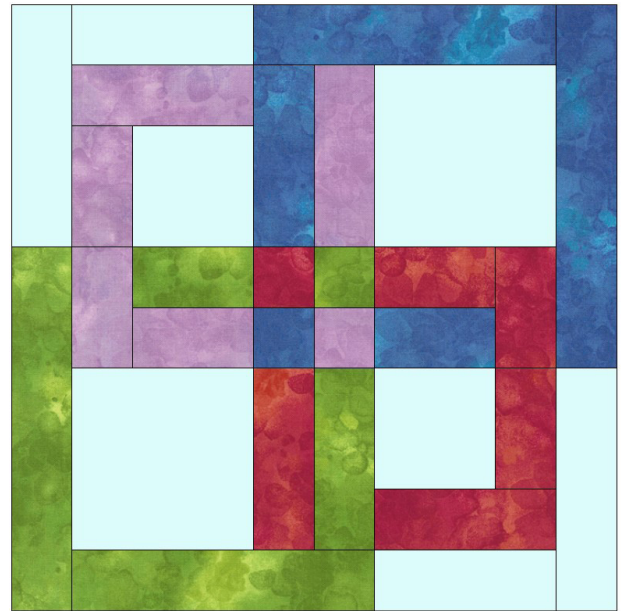
- 1 - 1½" x 1½" square
- 3 - 1½" x 2½" rectangles
- 2 - 1½" x 3½" rectangles

Cut the following from each of Lime and Sapphire:

- 1 - 1½" x 1½" square
- 1 - 1½" x 2½" rectangle
- 1 - 1½" x 3½" rectangle
- 1 - 1½" x 5½" rectangle

Block assembly:

- Arrange the squares and rectangles as shown in the diagram.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the units into sections as indicated to create the block. Press seams towards squares.
- Join the sections together.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to 10½" x 10½" if necessary.
