

Janome BOM

Block C / Month 3

You will need:

- Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

Cut:

Background fabric:

- 8 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSU.

Orange:

- 1 - 2½" square

Cherry:

- 4 - 2½" squares

Sky:

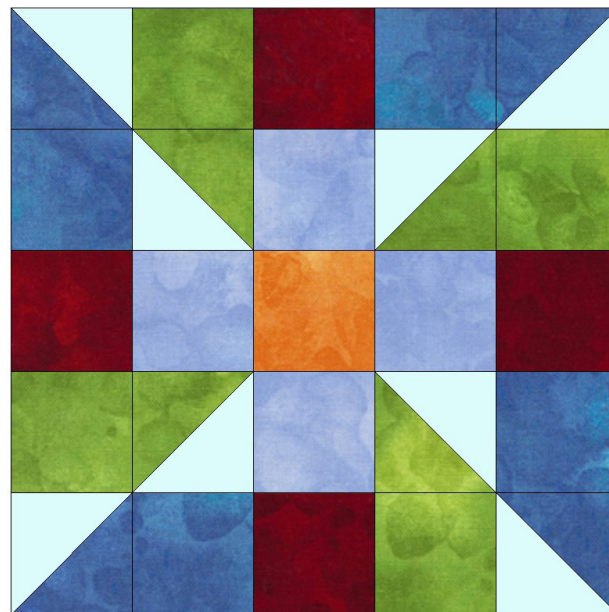
- 4 - 2½" squares

Cut the following from each of Lime and Sapphire:

- 4 - 2½" squares
- 4 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSD.

Block assembly:

- Sew the B triangles together to create the following HST units:
 - 4 - 2½" Background fabric / Sapphire HSTs; press seams towards background fabric
 - 4 - 2½" Background fabric / Lime HSTs; press seams towards Lime fabric
- Arrange the squares and HSTs as shown in the diagram.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the units into sections as indicated to create the block. Press seams towards squares and away from HSTs, when possible.
- Join the sections together.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to 10½" x 10½" if necessary.



Block size: 10" finished
(10½" unfinished).
