Janome BOM Block D / Month 4

You will need:

- Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

Cut:

Background fabric:

- 12 21/2" Side B triangles
- 8 1½" x 2½" rectangles

Magenta:

- 4 2½" squares
- 8 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSU

Royal:

• 4 - 21/2" Side B triangles with fabric RSD

Citrus:


• 1 - 21/2" square

Cut the following from each of Stone and Lagoon:

• 4 - 1½" x 2½" rectangles

Block assembly:

- Sew the 1½" x 2½" rectangles of Stone and Lagoon fabrics together. Make 4 and press the seams towards the Stone fabric in each double rectangle unit.
- Sew the B triangles as shown to create the following HST units:
 - 4 2½" Background fabric / Royal HSTs; press seams towards background fabric.
 - 8 2½" Background fabric / Magenta HSTs; press 4 seams toward background fabric and 4 seams toward Magenta fabric.
- Arrange the squares, rectangle units and HSTs as shown in the diagram.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the HSTs and squares into sections as indicated. Press the seams as shown.
- Join the sections together to construct the block.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " if necessary.
