Block H / Month 8

You will need:

- Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

Cut:

Background fabric #1:

- 1 - 6½" x 7" rectangle; use Precision Flying Geese Ruler to cut 1 - 6½" Side B triangle
- 16 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSU

Violet:

- 1 - 2½" x 4½" rectangle
- 1 - 2½" square
- 5 - 2½" Side B triangles

Cut the following from each of Grape, Lavender, Fuchsia, Royal, Sapphire, and Sky:

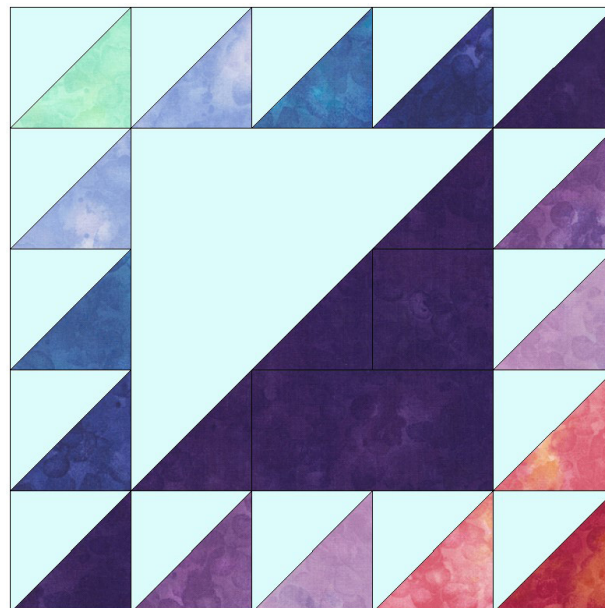
- 2 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSD

Cut the following from each of Mint and Magenta:

- 1 - 2½" Side B triangle with fabric RSD

Block assembly:

- Assemble the large Violet triangle as shown.
- Sew the pieced Violet triangle to the 6½" background B triangle to make a 6½" HST.
- Sew B fabric triangles to one each of Mint and Magenta fabrics to create 2½" HSTs.
- Sew B triangles to two each of Grape, Lavender, Fuchsia, Royal, Sapphire, and Sky fabrics to create 2½" HSTs.
- Press seams of all HSTs toward background fabric.
- Arrange the HSTs as shown in the diagram.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the HSTs into sections as indicated. Press the seams as shown.
- Join the sections together to construct the block.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to 10½" x 10½" if necessary.
