

Janome BOM

Block I / Month 9

You will need:

- Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

Cut:

Background fabric:

- 4 - 2½" squares
- 8 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSU
- 8 - 1½" squares

Citrus:

- 1 - 2½" square

Orange:

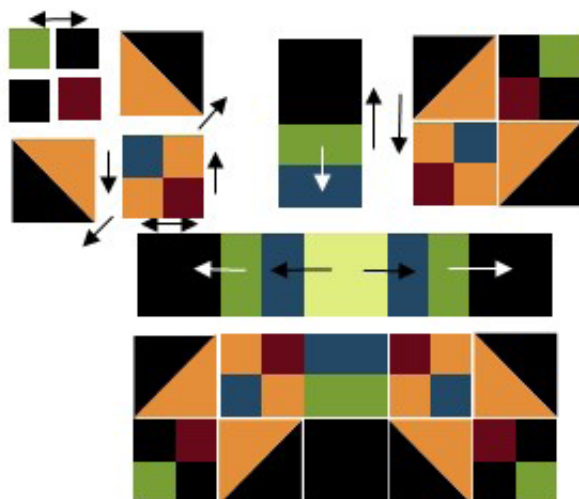
- 8 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSD
- 8 - 1½" squares

Cherry:

- 8 - 1½" squares

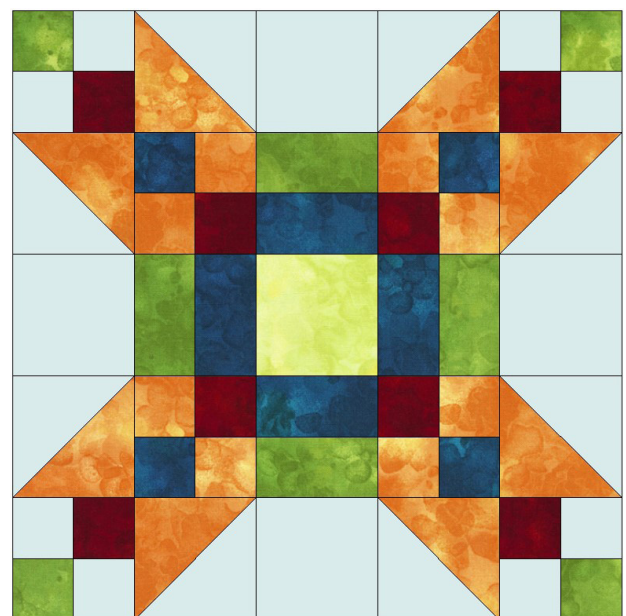
Cut the following from each of Azure and Lime:

- 4 - 1½" squares
- 4 - 1½" x 2½" rectangles



Block assembly:

- Construct the little four-patch units from the 1½" squares to make the following:
 - o 4 - 2½" four-patch units from background, Cherry and Lime fabrics.
 - o 4 - 2½" four-patch units from Orange, Azure and Cherry fabrics.
- Sew B fabric triangles together to create 8 - 2½" HSTs from Orange and background fabrics.
- Press seams toward background fabric.
- Sew Azure and Lime rectangles together to create 8-2½" double-rectangle units.
- Arrange the HSTs, four-patch and rectangle units as shown in the diagram.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the units into sections as indicated. Press the seams as shown.
- Join the sections together to construct the block.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to 10½" x 10½" if necessary.
