

# Janome BOM

## Block J / Month 10

### You will need:

- Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

### Cut:

#### Background fabric:

- 4 - 2½" Side A triangles
- 4 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSU

#### Stone:

- 1 - 2½" square
- 4 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric RSD

#### Cut the following from each of Fuchsia, Cherry, Lemon, Orange, Citrus, Green, Sky, and Royal

- 1 - 2½" Side A triangle
- 2 - 2½" Side B triangles with fabric strip folded in half

### Block assembly:

- Sew B triangles to the A (center) triangles to create the following 2½" x 4½" flying geese units:
  - Background fabric A triangle / Royal B triangles
  - Royal A triangle / Sky B triangles
  - Sky A triangle / Stone and background fabric B triangles
  - Background fabric A triangle / Cherry B triangles
  - Cherry A triangle / Fuchsia B triangles
  - Fuchsia A triangle / Stone and background fabric B triangles
  - Background fabric A triangle / Orange B triangles
  - Orange A triangle / Lemon B triangles
  - Lemon A triangle / Stone and background fabric B triangles
  - Background fabric A triangle / Green B triangles

- Green fabric A triangle / Citrus B triangles
- Citrus fabric A triangle / Stone and background fabric B triangles
- Arrange the flying geese units as shown in the diagram. Always press the seams toward the small, B triangles.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the flying geese units into sections as indicated. Press the seams as shown.
- Join the sections together to construct the block.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to 10½" x 10½" if necessary.
