

# Janome BOM

## Block L / Month 12

### You will need:

- Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

### Cut:

#### Green:

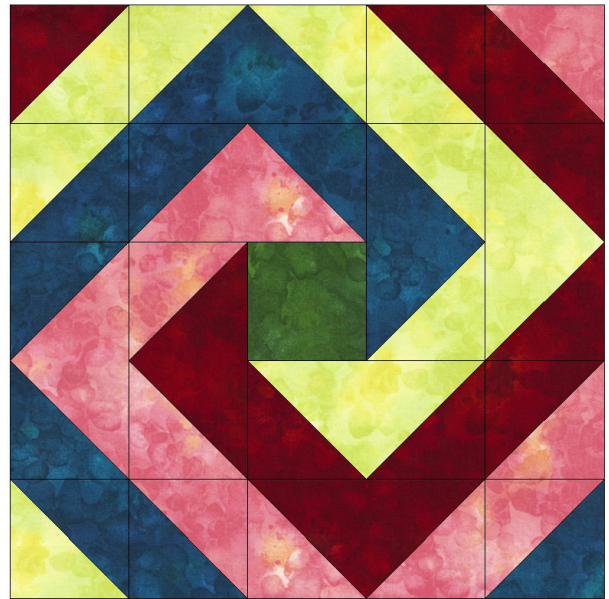
- 1 - 2½" square

#### Cut the following from each of Cherry, Fuchsia, Citrus and Azure:

- 1 - 2½" Side A triangle
- 5 - 2½" Side B triangle pairs

### Block assembly:

- Sew B triangles to the A (center) triangles to create the following 2½" x 4½" flying geese units:
  - Citrus A triangle / Cherry B triangles
  - Cherry A triangle / Fuchsia B triangles
  - Fuchsia A triangle / Azure B triangles
  - Azure A triangle / Citrus B triangles
- Sew B fabric triangles to make the following 2½" HSTs:
  - 4 - Citrus / Azure
  - 4 - Azure / Fuchsia
  - 4 - Fuchsia / Cherry
  - 4 - Cherry / Citrus
- Arrange the HSTs, square and flying geese units as shown in the diagram. Press seams as shown.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the flying geese units into sections as indicated.
- Join the sections together to construct the block.
- Use the Precision Precuts Ruler to square-up the block to 10½" x 10½" if necessary.
