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Cutting Chart and Overview:

All blocks measure 8½" x 8½" unfinished unless otherwise noted.

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Block G

Cut:


Background fabric: $12 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " Side B triangles Grape, Lavender, Violet: $4 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " Side B triangles Pansy and Lemonade: $2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " Side A triangles

Block Construction:

- Construct 4 Flying Geese units, which should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- Create 4 quadrants, each with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " HST, and a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Flying Geese unit.
- Assemble the block like a four-patch unit.
- Press the seams as shown by the arrows.

NOTE: When pressing seams for the Lavender/Violet and Grape/Violet HSTs, they are pressed in opposite directions for each pair.

- The double-ended arrows mean to press seams open.
- Square-up the block to 8½" x 8½".



Block H

Cut:


Background fabric: 4 - 2½" Side A triangles; 4 - 2½" Side B triangles

Flame: 4 - 2½" Side B triangles

Lemon and Orange: Use 8 - 2½" Side B triangles you cut previously

Block Construction:

- Construct the center HST four-patch unit which should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- Then construct 4 Flying Geese units. FG units should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- Add the 2½" HSTs to the top and bottom FG units, and the side FG units to the center pinwheel unit to create three rows, as shown.
- To nest seams, press the seams as shown by the arrows.
- Square-up the block to $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Block I

Cut:


Background fabric: 8 - 1½" x 2½" rectangles; 16 - 1½" Side B triangles

Cherry and Maraschino: 2 - 21/2" squares

Lemonade and Pink: 4 - 1½" x 51/4" rectangles

Block Construction:

- Use the 2 ½" line on the Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler to cut the Lemonade and Pink 1 ½" x 5 ¼" rectangles to create trapezoids. (Follow along with the video.)
- Sew $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background fabric rectangles to each side of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " maraschino and cherry squares.
- Sew 1½" background fabric Side B triangles to the lemonade and pink trapezoids.
- Create 4 quadrants as shown & assemble the block like a four-patch unit.
- To nest seams, press the seams as shown by the arrows.
- Square-up the block to $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".
