Flying Geese Border and Quilt Construction

You will need:

- Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler
- Precision Jelly Roll Ruler OR Precision Precuts Ruler
- ¼" piecing foot (with or without guide) OR HP foot and plate system
- 2.4 stitch length
- 50wt. cotton thread in top and bobbin, neutral color or match background fabric

Cut:

Background fabric:

- 32 - 2½" Side B triangle pairs from fabric strip folded in half

From a variety of colors:

- 32 - 2½" Side A triangles

Block assembly:

- Sew background fabric B triangles and a variety of A triangles to create 32 - 2½" x 4½" flying geese units.
- Press the seams toward the small B triangles.
- Square-up the flying geese units to 2½" x 4½" if necessary.
- Arrange the flying geese units as shown in the diagram.
- Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the flying geese units into the four sections as indicated.
 - Section M = 13 flying geese units
 - Section N = 5 flying geese units
 - Section O = 10 flying geese units
 - Section P = 4 flying geese units
- Join the sections with the background fabric pieces to create the borders after the quilt top has been assembled.
