

WET BAG TUTORIAL

MATERIALS NEEDED

- 1/3 YARD OF 12-16 GAGUE VINYL
- 1 FAT QUARTER FABRIC
- 1 14" ZIPPER
- [TYPICAL SEWING SUPPLIES](#)
- (OPTIONAL) TEFLON FOOT

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) 12" x 21" OF 12-16 GAGUE VINYL
- (2) 12" x 8" OF QUILTING COTTON



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. FOLD AND PRESS THE QUILTING COTTON STRIPS WITH WRONG SIDES FACING SO THE 12" EDGES MEET. FOLD AND PRESS THE 12" EDGES OF THE QUILTING COTTON TOWARDS THE WRONG SIDE AT 3/8".

2. SANDWICH ONE 12" EDGE OF THE VINYL INTO ONE OF THE QUILTING COTTON PIECES. OVERLAP BY 1/2" AND TOP STITCH ALONG THE FOLDED ENDS. REPEAT FOR THE OTHER SIDE.

3. FOLD THE VINYL SO THE ENDS OF THE TWO FABRIC PIECES ARE MEETING WITH WRONG SIDES TOGETHER. ALIGN THE ZIPPER IN PLACE, PIN AND TOP STITCH BESIDE THE ZIPPER TEETH.

4. ALIGN THE BAG RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER BEING SURE THE FABRIC PIECES ARE ALIGNED CORRECTLY. USE WONDERCLIPS TO HOLD IN PLACE AND SEW ALONG THE SIDES. USE YOUR TEFLON FOOT TO MAKE IT EASIER FOR THE VINYL TO FEED THROUGH YOUR MACHINE.
