


Cutting chart and overview.

	Block 7	<p>Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler</p> <p>Precision Jelly Roll</p>	<p>Background fabric:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 - 3 1/2" strip; subcut 2 - 3 1/2"x 10" rectangle (A), • 1- 3 1/2"x 9" rectangle (B) <p>Fabrics #1: select a panel print</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 - 7 1/2" x 10" small panels (D). <p>Fabrics #2: from Hearts and Stars Navy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 - 3 1/2" strip; subcut 2 - 3 1/2"x 9" rectangle (B), • 2 - 3 1/2"x 7 1/2" rectangle (C)
	Block 8	<p>Precision Precuts Ruler</p>	<p>Use template plastic to create templates for A and C triangles.</p> <p>Background fabric:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 - 4" x 5" rectangles (E). • 4 - 10 1/2" x 4 1/4" rectangles. Use Template A to cut 4 triangles from the rectangles. • 4 - 8" x 5 1/4" rectangles. Use Template C to cut 4 triangles from the rectangles <p>Fabrics #1: select two panel prints</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 - 7 1/2" x 9 1/2" small panels (F). <p>Fabrics #2: from Waves Teal and Floating Yellow</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 - 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" rectangles. (B1, B2, D1, D2).

Blocks #7

To make the Spool block:


- Pair Background B rectangle and Fabric #2 B rectangle with **RST**, using Precision Flying Geese & HST Ruler cut 4 sets of **Side B HST** units (For Full HST Instructions-See Month 1: Project Overview pg.8.) Stitch units together. Press seam towards fabric #2.
- The **HST** units should measure $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
- Sew a **C** rectangle between two **HST** units, press seams toward **C** rectangle.
- The new rectangle units should measure $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 13\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
- Sew background fabric **A** rectangles to each side of a panel **D**.
- Square-up all pieced units if necessary, then sew all the units to create the block.
- The Spool block should measure $13\frac{1}{2}'' \times 16''$ unfinished.



Blocks #8


To make Elongated Star blocks:

- Take 2 - $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$ rectangles right sides up. Cut them once diagonally, exactly in the orientation as shown. Label these **B1** triangles.
- Take 2 - $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$ rectangle right sides up. Cut them once diagonally, exactly in the orientation as shown. Label these **B2** triangles.
- Take 2 - $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$ rectangles right sides up. Cut them once diagonally, exactly in the orientation as shown. Label these **D1** triangles.
- Take 2 - $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$ rectangles right sides up. Cut them once diagonally, exactly in the orientation as shown. Label these **D2** triangles.




Month #4

- Place a **B1** triangle **RST** on top of the **A** and stitch.
 Press the seam allowance toward the **B1** triangle.
 - Add the **B2** triangle **RST** on top of the **A** and stitch.
 Press the seam allowance toward the **B2** triangle.
- Be careful to leave ¼" seam allowance at the point, as shown by the red circle.
- Unit should measure 9½" x 4" unfinished. Square-up, if necessary.
 - Make 2 - **A/B1/B2** units for each star block.



- Place a **D1** triangle **RST** on top of the **C** and stitch.
 Press the seam allowance toward the **D1** triangle.
 - Add the **D2** triangle **RST** on top of the **C** and stitch.
 Press the seam allowance toward the **D2** triangle.
- Be careful to leave ¼" seam allowance at the point, as shown by the red circle.
- Units should measure 7½" x 5" unfinished. Square-up, if necessary.
 - Make 2 - **C/D1/D2** units for each star block.



- Add the **A/B1/B2** units to each side of the **F (center)**.
 Press the seam allowances toward the center square.
- Sew **E** patch background fabric rectangles to each side of the **C/D1/D2** units. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles.
- Sew the units as shown.
- The block should measure 14½" x 18½" unfinished.
- Square-up, if necessary. Make 2 elongated star blocks.
