From each of the following: Hearts and Stars Yellow, Loves Navy, Scripts Pink and Waves Sunshine 1- 5" square for heart appliqué
	Block 5		Background fabric: Use the 2 - 5½" x 5½" squares (Blocks #5A) and 6½" x 6½" square (Block #5B) you cut and labled in Month 1. From the following 2- 4½" x 4½" square (small stars): Waves Sunshine & Hearts and Stars Navy 1 - 5"x 5" square (large star): Script Navy
	Block 6		Background fabric: Use the 8½" x 8½" square you cut and labled in Month 1. From the following 1-2" square for Small circle, Floating Yellow 1-2½" square for Large Circle, Floating Rose 6-3½" x 12" pieces for Petals, Floating Blue

All background fabric squares measure 6½" x 6½" unfinished.









Blocks #5A and #5B


Two background fabric squares measure 5½" x 5½", and one square measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.







Block #6 Background fabric square measures 8½" x 8½" unfinished.



Fusible machine appliqué technique

- Trace the appliqué shapes onto the paper side of the fusible web, leaving approximately ½" of space between each motif. Then, rough-cut the shapes, leaving a 1/4" margin outside the drawn lines.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions to fuse the appliqué shapes to the wrong side of the fabrics, as outlined in the cutting instructions.
- Cut out the shapes along the solid drawn line.
- Remove the paper backing from the cut shapes and position them as illustrated on assigned background fabric blocks, noted below. Press in place, following the manufacturer's instructions.
 - 4 heart shapes to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
 - 2 small star shapes to 5½" x 5½" squares.
 - 1 large star shape to 6½" x 6½" square.
 - Petals and circles to 8½" x 8½" square.
- Place a piece of tear-away stabilizer on the back of each block. Using the thread color of choice, machine appliqué-stitch around the edges of the shapes to secure them in place.
- Carefully remove the stabilizer from around the outside and inside of your sewn shapes.
- Press the blocks to ensure they lay flat


For machine appliqué

I recommend a single (appliqué) blanket stitch:

- Stitch width setting of 2.5 or 3.0
- Stitch length setting of 2.0


